

Ownership and Agricultural Holdings/Tenant CERTIFICATE A

Use **Certificate A** where all of the land is owned by the applicant

Use **Certificate B** where there are other owners and serve **Notice** on all of them.

Ownership Certificate A

I certify that on the day 21 days before the date of the accompanying application nobody, except the applicant, was the owner (a) of any part of the land to which the application relates.

Agricultural Holdings Certificate

If the applicant is the sole agricultural tenant he or she must delete the first alternative and insert "not applicable" as the information required by the second alternative.
