### **Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012**

#### **Notice of Urgent Key Decision(s) and Private meetings**

The Council is required to give up to 5 days' notice if it intends to make an urgent key decision. If it is impracticable to comply with this requirement the Council must give notice of the reasons why the making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

The Executive intends to meet on the 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2013 and consider the following key decision(s). It has not been possible to give the required notice for the reasons stated:

Key Decision	Reason why the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred
Weavers' Triangle Public Realm – contracts - private item – information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information)	This is urgent because there is a tight deadline before which the externally sourced funding must be defrayed; it has not been possible to finalise the report sooner because of negotiations with one of the external funders about the terms and conditions of their funding offer.
