### Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

#### Private meeting - Agreement of Scrutiny Committee Chair under Regulation 5 (6) (a) and Regulation 11

Under these Regulations the Council is required to give 28 days notice if it intends to hold a meeting of the Executive in private or partly in private. This is done on occasions where there is a report which contains confidential information.

If the Council is not able to give the required notice it must obtain the agreement of the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee or in his absence the Mayor, and publish a copy of that notice (Regulation 7).

Set out below is a notice given in line with these requirements.
