

**The Control of Waste (Dealing with Seized Property)  
(England and Wales) Regulations 2015**

**NOTICE OF SEIZURE OF PROPERTY**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT Lancashire Police, on behalf of Burnley Borough Council, the seizure authority for the purpose of the above Regulations, has seized property of the following description:

Any claim must be made by **20/11/2018** (being 15 working days after the date of this notice)

Documents required for a valid claim of entitlement

1. Proof of I.D. – valid photo card (driving licence or passport)
2. Proof of address (e.g. two utility bills in the applicants name no older than 3 months)
3. Vehicle Registration document for seized property
4. Valid insurance
5. Written proof of authority to act as agent IF acting in a representative capacity (e.g. valid power of attorney + items 3-4 above and proof of ID and address of agent)

The seizure authority may be of the opinion that it is necessary to retain the seized property for the duration of an investigation or criminal proceedings.

A seizure authority may sell, destroy or otherwise dispose of seized property where a seizure notice has been published and

1. The claim period of 15 working days has ended and no claim was made; or
2. A claim was made within the claim period, but the seizure authority did not determine that the claimant was entitled to the property.

A copy of this notice has been served on the Chief Constable of Lancashire Police, and in the case of a vehicle, the registered keeper and any other person identified as entitled to possession of the vehicle, and has been published on the seizure authority's website ([www.burnley.gov.uk](http://www.burnley.gov.uk)). This is in accordance with regulations 7, 8 and 9 of the above Regulations
