- 1 If natural (as described in Ordnance Survey MasterMap attributes)
- 2 If developing into natural looking habitat
- 3 If private with no public access
- 4 If access is restricted e.g entrance fee is charged or restricted hours
- 5 If access is restricted e.g club membership or school sports facilities
- 6 If entrance fee or restricted opening hours or restricted access (i.e. grounds of sports club)
- 7 If no restrictions on access
- 8 If publically accessible and used for recreation, i.e not within school/private grounds, not small areas within housing developments or roadside strips
- 9 If open access land (within a park or garden, Local Nature Reserve (LNR), within open access area, identified in woods for people/public open space dataset, has a PROW or safe travel route passing through it)
- 10 If adjacent to open access land (as in 9)
- 11 If natural and within econetwork dataset (intersects dataset)
- 12 Within 10m of PROW, Cycle Routes or Promoted Paths, except where adjacent to Motorway
- 13 Within 10m of PROW, Cycle Routes or Promoted Paths, except where adjacent to Motorway or if golf course/large accessible outdoor sports facility
- 14 If contains significant tree cover (Ordnance Survey MasterMap description contains trees, contains or within 2m of street trees point data)
- 15 If on peaty soils or contain significant tree cover (is in 14)
- 16 Contains significant tree cover (as in 14) and is within 250m of trunk roads, motorways and rail lines
- 17 Within 250m of trunk roads, motorways and rail lines (intersects buffer)
- 18 If within a designated site (e.g. Ramsar, SPA, SAC, SSSI, NNR, Biodiversity Heritage Sites, LNR, BAP habitats - from Ph 1 habitat data) (within or centroid within)
- 19 If natural and within a designated site (e.g. Ramsar, SPA, SAC, SSSI, NNR, Biodiversity Heritage Sites, LNR, BAP habitats) (within or centroid within)
- 20 If managed for wildlife or within a designated site (e.g. Ramsar, SPA, SAC, SSSI, NNR, Biodiversity Heritage Sites, LNR, BAP habitats) (within or centroid within)
- 21 Within econetwork dataset (intersects dataset)
- 22 Formal designation (Scheduled monument, English Heritage Park and Garden, Battlefields, Listed Buildings) (Centroid within 50m buffer)
- 23 Ancient woodland (excluding PAWS) and or within English Heritage Park and Garden
- 24 Canals
- 25 Village Greens
- 26 If space is used for cultural purposes, public are, events, festivals etc. (Panopticon) or within Park or Public Garden/Cemetery, Churchyard or Burial Ground
- 27 If trees are of significant size
- 28 If in natural substrate (exclude Street Trees located on Manmade surfaces in MasterMap)
- 29 If within 2m of a watercourse
- 30 If water flows through (i.e. linked to a watercourse)
- 31 If contains high levels of vegetation (Ordnance Survey MasterMap description trees, scrub, grassland etc or contains or within 2m of street trees point data)
- 32 If not manmade and contains high levels of vegetation (Ordnance Survey MasterMap description trees, scrub, grassland etc or contains or within 2m of street trees point data)
- 33 If within school grounds or within 480m of a school and also functioning as publically accessible recreational asset
