### Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements)(Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

#### Private meeting

#### Agreement of Scrutiny Committee Chair under Regulation 5 (6) (a)

Under these Regulations the Council is required to give 28 days notice if it intends to hold a meeting of the Executive in private or partly in private. This is done on occasion where there is a report that contains confidential information. If the Council is not able to give the required notice it must obtain the agreement of the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee that the making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred, and publish a copy of that notice.

The Council is also required to give at least 5 days notice if it intends to make an urgent private decision.

If the Council is not able to give the required notice it must obtain the agreement of the Chair of the Scrutiny Committee or other relevant person for the decision to be made as a case of special urgency and then give notice of the reasons why the making of the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred for the reason stated.

The Chair of the Scrutiny Committee has given agreement on 29<sup>th</sup> November 2016 that the Executive Member for Resources and Performance Management intends to consider the following private decision.
