1. Nomination Papers

2. Delivery of Nomination Papers

Nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Elections Office, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA on any day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm, (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Friday, 6th April 2018.

3. Poll

If any election is contested a poll will take place on Thursday, 3rd May 2018 between 7am and 10pm.

4. Registration

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on 17th April 2018. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register tovot e.

5. Absent Votes

New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal vote or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Wednesday, 18th April 2018.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Wednesday 25th April 2018.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Thursday 3rd May 2018. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Tuesday 25th April 2018. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 25th April 2018.
