<p>PI2c: In partnership, continue to develop a balanced approach to delivery of environmental services</p>	<p>The final 6 alleygating schemes from the 2007-08 programme should be complete by the end of November. Up to 10 new schemes will be considered by the strategic alleygating group in October. The MAPS team coordinated a successful clean-up of the Sedbergh Street garage site and fly-tipping at Spa Street. Streetscene Pilots have been conducted in Bank Hall and Burnley Wood, aimed at helping people to access refuse and recycling services to reduce fly-tipping and increase pride in their local environment, backed up by enforcement where necessary. Participation in recycling is up to 50% and fly-tipping has reduced. 2 dog fouling cases dealt with in September - neither defendant attended. Case 1 - fined £150, Costs £125 + investigation costs of £38 plus £15 victim surcharge. Case 2 - fined £150, Costs £125 + investigation costs of £47.50 plus £15 victim surcharge. Successful prosecution of a pub landlord for unlawful waste disposal. The defendant entered a guilty plea and was fined £300 plus total of £300 prosecution costs and £15 victim surcharge.</p>
