Election of Leader of the Council

PURPOSE

1. To consider the election of the Leader of the Council and the Executive.

RECOMMENDATION

2. The Council are asked to Elect the Leader of the Council, agree the number of members to be appointed to the Executive and make those appointments.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION

3. To enable the Council to appoint the leader and the Executive.

SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS

4. The Council's Constitution sets out within the Council procedure rules, the rules to be followed at the meeting which elects the Leader of the Council.
5. The constitution provides that the Council will at a meeting held on the day after the Annual Meeting:
 - (i) Elect the leader;
 - (ii) Elect Members of the Executive. This will be achieved by inviting the Leader, following his/her appointment, to propose to the Council meeting the Members to be appointed to the Executive.Any candidate for the office of Leader should consult the Leaders of all other political groups represented on the Council before making his/her proposals.
