1. Nomination Papers

2. Delivery of Nomination Papers

Nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Elections Office, Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA on any day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm, (excluding bank holidays) but no later than 4pm on Wednesday 3rd, April 2019.

3. Poll

If any election is contested a poll will take place on Thursday, 2nd May 2019 between 7am and 10pm.

4. Registration

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Friday 12th April 2019. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register tovote.

5. Absent Votes

New applications to vote by post, and amendments or cancellations of existing postal vote or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Monday, 15th April 2019.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Wednesday 24th April 2019.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Manchester Road, Burnley, BB11 9SA by 5pm on Thursday 2nd May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 24th April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 24th April 2019.
