What is Burnley's Local Plan?

Burnley's Local Plan is the framework that will shape the future of the borough of Burnley to 2026.

It will be the basis for making important decisions about growth and development in the borough. It will look at issues such as the provision of new housing, jobs and infrastructure. It will guide regeneration and investment. The Local Plan will also ensure that Burnley and Padiham's heritage and natural environment are protected, and that land is used in a sustainable way.

When can I get involved?

Your local knowledge and interest are vital to help Burnley Council plan for the future.

We will be consulting on the issues facing the borough and options for its future development in early 2013 so that you can tell us what is important to you.

Taking into account what you've told us, we'll then draw up a draft Burnley Local Plan for you to comment on. This will be in autumn 2013.

We'll go through all of the comments we receive and then prepare a final version of the Local Plan – the submission plan. We'll be publishing this in summer 2014. You can let us know what you think about the submission plan – but it is not the Council who will consider your comments. Instead, they will be looked at by an independent planning inspector.
