
### 5. Organisation Review

- Purpose** To seek approval for arrangements as a result of the new organisational operating model approved at Executive on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016.
- Reason For Decision** To allow the timely and efficient implementation of the new organisational operating model approved at Executive on 21<sup>st</sup> November 2016 which confirmed a reduction in the size of the senior management structure. This is as a consequence of a workforce reduced to 220 FTE following the strategic partnership with Liberata, the need to take further costs out of the senior management structure and the need for additional savings to meet predicted budget shortfalls up to 2019.
- Decision** That approval be given to the arrangements as detailed in paragraph 5 of the report as submitted.

The decision is urgent due to the need for a timely and efficient implementation of the new organisational operating model and is therefore not subject to call in, in accordance with Part 4.5 of the Constitution.
